Food Safety



Mid-Ohio Foodbank is dedicated to ensuring safe food handling throughout its distribution practice. It is very important to provide fresh produce to our communities in need, and it is equally important to distribute food that is suitable for consumption. Please take a look at the following guidelines regarding distributing food through the Mobile Market Program. In signing on as a partnering agency, you are also in agreement in distributing food in the manner identified below:

- All your volunteers should wash their hands
- Provide a clean surface for all fresh food and produce
- Hand sanitizer and gloves must be available on-site
- Any ill volunteers should not handle food
(ex. nausea, diarrhea, fever, sore throat, jaundice, exposed lesions or wounds, or food-bourne illness)
- No produce boxes/produce should be on the ground
- Loose leafy vegetables, like lettuce, should be distributed wearing gloves
- Soft produce that can be easily pierced such as ripe plums and peaches, should be distributed wearing gloves
(Or ask the recipient to take the produce themselves)
- Do not offer samples unless washed
