

Eligibility for SNAP (Food Assistance) benefits is based primarily on gross income and household size. Your household consists of all the people with whom you share meals.

Your gross monthly income must be equal to or less than these amounts based on household size:

Household size	1	2	3	4	5	6	+1
Monthly Gross	\$1,265	\$1,705	\$2,144	\$2,584	\$3,024	\$3,464	+\$440

Here are the documents you will need to complete your application:

Identification

- ___ Social security card or proof that you have applied for one for each member of the household,
- ___ Proof of identity (picture ID); for example, your driver's license or state ID
- ___ Permanent resident card or I-94 for immigrants.
(You do not need a birth certificate to get food assistance)

Income & Expenses

Proof of:

- ___ Household income (for the past 30 days),
- ___ Housing & utility costs (including gas, electric, phone, water, garbage, sewage from the most recent 30 days)
- ___ Medical expenses if you are disabled or 60 years of age or older
- ___ Childcare & other dependent expenses
- ___ Child support paid
