- Your assets remain in your control during your lifetime.

HOW TO MAKE A CHARITABLE BEQUEST

You can make a bequest by including language in your will that names Mid-Ohio Foodbank as the beneficiary of your entire estate, or you can designate that a specific dollar amount, a particular asset, or a fixed percentage of your estate goes to Mid-Ohio Foodbank after ensuring that your family is cared for.
