On Go Orange Day, Mid-Ohio Foodbank will join peers from around the country for Congressional visits in support of a Farm Bill that protects federal nutrition programs and Americans facing hunger. The visits will include Ohio Senators Sherrod Brown and Rob Portman as well as Congresswoman Marcia Fudge and Congressmen Steve Chabot and Bob Gibbs. The message will be to support the Senate version of the Farm Bill, which is much more favorable than the House version for SNAP, TEFAP and other program funding and does not contain punitive work requirements.
